Top Contributors to State Candidates

When a committee (a person or group of people who receive or spend money for the purpose of influencing voters to support or oppose candidates) raises at least \$1 million, it must report its top 10 contributors to the California Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC). The committee must update the list when there is any change.

Track Your Ballot

All voters can get critical updates on their ballots through California's official "Where's My Ballot?" tracking tool. Signing up takes less than three minutes!

You can select to receive notifications on the status of your ballot by text (SMS), email, or voice call, including alerts if there are any issues with your ballot and instructions for how to correct them to make sure your vote is counted.
